Ukrainian Association of Vascular Access

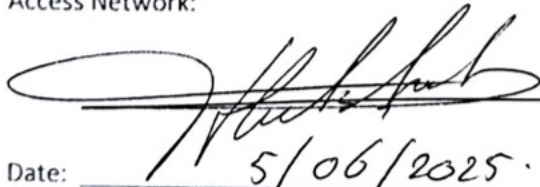
The Global Vascular Access Network (GloVANet) and the Ukrainian Association of Vascular Access hereby commit themselves to a relationship agreement aimed at contributing to an international partnership whose purpose is to extend the mission of GloVANet and Ukrainian Association of Vascular Access, to enhance the vascular access specialty worldwide, and to improve vascular access through an evidence-based approach and best practice. These goals are to be achieved through the two vascular access organizations cooperating with each other by engaging in the types of activities that will be the leading voice and resource of the vascular community in their countries and offers opportunities for networking and sharing of clinical evidence and experience to promote international best practice in vascular access.

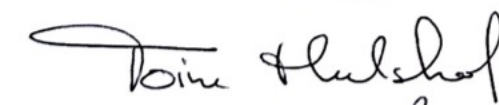
This Agreement serves as the foundation upon which the organizations undertake to proactively promote and support each other, under a program-driven and networking partnership. Within the framework of this Agreement, both organizations will:

1. Have as their overall objectives the promotion of best clinical vascular access practices to the benefit of the vascular access community, resulting in better patient outcomes;
2. Jointly formulate, establish, maintain, manage and monitor a co-operative relationship that will be mutually beneficial, reciprocal and supporting, aimed at the attainment of the organizations' priorities and the needs of the communities they represent;
3. Ensure that the relationship brings net benefits to each organization and their constituencies in the vascular access community; and
4. In pursuit of the above goals, appropriate representatives of the two organizations may collaborate to prepare mutually agreed programs comprising specific projects and initiatives.

Mindful of the above objectives, a representative of the GloVANet organization and an eligible representative of the Ukrainian Association of Vascular Access confirm that an official Friendship Agreement henceforth unites these two organizations.
